Location	Predominantly based in Northfleet however various locations as required to fulfil the role.
Working pattern and Work base	6 hours per week You will be required to work evenings during the week and weekends.
Summary	The Position is a part-time position and will be responsible for providing medical coverage for the Women's First Team.
	The Women's Sports Therapist will assess, diagnose and treat player injuries.
	This Position requires flexibility and a willingness to work non-standard hours in accordance with the needs of the Club. The successful candidate will be required at home fixtures along with travelling to away fixtures with the First Team.
	You must be adaptable and able to quickly adjust to the requirements of the role, also forming positive relationships with other team members and demonstrating commitment to the Club's ambitions.
Objective of the role	As the Women's Sports Therapist, you will be responsible for:
	 Attending all training sessions and games during pre-season and normal season; Medical screenings for the current squad; Soft tissue management and treatment as part of pre-training and pre-match preparation (such as strapping and massage) as well as other modalities; Assessing and treating injuries which occur during training sessions and matches; Managing injured players through their rehabilitation and return to play programs; Keeping current and accurate medical notes; and Maintaining a regular and current CPD portfolio.

Qualifications and experiences	 Must hold a minimum qualification of Emergency First Aid in Football (EFAiF); Ideally hold a BSc/MSc in a relevant field (physiotherapy, sport rehabilitation, or sport therapy) and hold a current registration with the Health and Care Professions Council; Must hold a current full UK drivers' licence; and Must have previous experience working pitchside and in a similar role at a professional football club.
