elcome to your free online edition of *Fleet Review* as we take a closer look at a side we have never met in a competitive game before – Beckenham Town. They were enjoying a fine season in the SCEFL when Covid robbed them of a likely league title but they since switched leagues to the Combined Counties, winning that in 2021/22 to earn promotion to the Isthmian and their highest level yet.

Last season, the visitors enjoyed their best-ever FA Cup run to the Fourth Qualifying Round, disposing of Dartford along the way and reached the play-offs. Beckenham began this season with some well-known non-league names including Danny Waldren (Bromley), Richard Orlu (Dover Athletic) and Louie Theophanous (Chelmsford City, Farnborough, Billericay Town) but have seen players depart mid-season and a struggle in the league has ensued, with the club currently at the foot of the Isthmian South-East Division.

In the last round of the Kent Senior Cup that they lost at Dover (but were subsequently reinstated), the Becks played a mix of first-team and academy players – and with survival in the league still very much on the cards (they are six points adrift but enjoy two games in hand and a better goal difference), that may very well be the case again tonight against a Fleet team that will likely have a couple of academy faces too, alongside those first-teamers in need of extra minutes.

Beckenham got an excellent draw at the weekend at fourthplaced Lancing, denied a win only by a 93rd minute equaliser. From a Fleet perspective, Danny Searle wants to maintain the winning feeling in a week where there is no Saturday game ahead so it's all to play for as Chatham Town await tonight's winners.



#### Abbas Agoro

Midfielder formerly with AFC Croydon Athletic for several seasons where he was captain. He signed for Beckenham earlier this campaign.

#### Eri Akintimehin

The attacking midfielder or left winger has come from local football and previously played for Erith & Belvedere, Whitstable Town and Lydd Town, from where he recently moved to Beckenham.

#### **Donnell Anderson**

Utility midfielder or full-back previously with Hollands & Blair and before that Sutton Athletic, Herne Bay, Phoenix Sports, Barking , Rochester United and Bromley's academy.

#### **Foların Awoleke**

New signing who has experience with VCD Athletic, Witham Town, Long Buckby, Kempston, Wellingborough and Enfield. A central defender or midfielder who is adaptable in numerous positions.

#### **Alfie Bloomfield**

The forward made the move from Sittingbourne in January, returning to the Becks who he played for previously. He was at Bromley and AFC Croydon Athletic while he spent most of this season on Ioan at the Fleet's near neighbours Punjab United, where he scored five goals.

#### **Rob Carter**

Club captain and a former U18 England schoolboy international who joined the Becks from AFC Croydon Athletic in 2019. An old-fashioned centre-back and clever player who loves the art of defending, hates conceding goals and relishes a big tackle.

#### Joe Chalker

A winger signed in January from SCEFL side Erith Town, where he graduated to the senior side from the club's academy. This season he has made 11 appearances and scored two goals.

#### Jeremiah Frimpong

Recent signing from Baldock Town.

#### **Henry Griffin**

Now in his second season with the Becks, the full-back arrived from Dartford where he had played U19 football.

#### Segun Ikudehinbu

Nigerian defensive midfielder who has played abroad, mainly in Finland with Atlantis, Warkaus, JIPPO and KuPS, as well as in Romania with FC Piatra. Closer to home he has played for K Sports and Welling Town.

#### Nathan Paul-Lavaly

Signed on loan from Bromley, the former youth player came through the Ravens' academy to the U21s and has made the bench twice this season for the National League club's first team.

#### **Tyrone Pink**

Experienced winger who started out with the Metropolitan Police and also enjoyed spells with AFC Croydon Athletic, Redhill, Chalfont St Peter, Bedford Town, Southall, Uxbridge, Northwood and Egham Town. He signed for Beckenham in 2021.

#### **Fin Roberts**

A January loan signing from Bromley's academy who has also spent time with Redhill earlier this season. The highly rated young attacking player has added pace and flair to the Becks attack since signing.

#### **Terlochan Singh**

The midfielder played for Brightlingsea Regent in the Isthmian Premier where he was club captain before a move to Sittingbourne last season. He also captained Glebe and Sporting Bengal and has played for Hanwell Town. 'Toch' is also a member of the England Police Football side and represented Panjab at the 2016 and 2018 CONIFA World Cup.

#### Steven Townsend

A forward who won promotion and enjoyed a record FA Cup run with the Becks, the left-sided attacking player scored goals aplenty locally with Farnborough Old Boys Guild before settling in at semi-pro level with Beckenham from 2019. He returned to football after a serious collar bone injury.

#### **Marcus Travers**

Powerful and commanding centre-back who is comfortable on the ball and strong in the air. A recent arrival, his previous clubs include Corinthian Casuals, Tunbridge Wells, Tooting & Mitcham United, Canterbury City, Chipstead, Redhill and AFC Croydon Athletic.

#### Mudiaga Wanogho

A calm and uncompromising centre-back who joined from neighbours Fisher in 2019. Strong, quick and resolute in the tackle he is an immovable force of nature at the heart of the Becks backline.

#### **Rhys Whyborn**

A defender signed on loan in January from Bromley. The full back has played U18 and U21 football for Bromley, as well as appearaing for the first team in pre-season. He has already had a loan spell this season, turning out for Combined Counties side Redhill and he scored at the weekend for Beckenham.



## **BECKENHAM TOWN – CLUB HISTORY**

THE ORIGINAL Beckenham Town were established in the late 19th century, affiliating to the Kent County Football Association in 1887. In 1923 the club joined Division One of the London League.

They won Division One in 1927/28, and were promoted to the Premier Division. However, after finishing second-from-bottom in their first season in the Premier Division, they ended the 1929/30 season in last place, and were relegated back to Division One.

The following season saw them finish second in Division One, earning promotion back to the Premier Division. Despite finishing bottom of the Premier Division in 1931/32 they remained in the division, but after repeating the feat in 1932/33, they were relegated back to Division One.

After finishing bottom of Division One in 1934/35 the club left the league. They had also entered a team into the Kent County Amateur League a few seasons before, and continued playing in the Premier Division of the Western Section until rejoining the London League in 1951, where they were



placed in the Premier Division.

They remained in the London League's Premier Division until joining the Aetolian League in 1961. This merged with the London League in 1964 to form the Greater London League, with Beckenham placed in Section B. A fifth-place finish in the league's inaugural season saw them win a place in the Premier Division for the 1965/66 season. However. after finishing second-frombottom of the division that season, they were relegated to Division One. They folded in 1969.

In 1971 the club was reformed based on the Stanhope Rovers junior team. After playing in the South East London Amateur League, they joined Division Two of the new London Spartan League in 1975.

After being runners-up in 1977/78, they were promoted to the Premier Division. In 1982 they transferred to Division One of the Kent League, which became the Premier Division in 1998.

They finished as runners-up in 2005/06. The league was subsequently renamed the Southern Counties East League in 2013. The club won both the Kent Senior Trophy and the League Cup in 2013/14, and went on to win the Roy Vinter Shield at the start of the 2014/15 season. In 2019/20 the club was top of the league when the season was abandoned due to the COVID-19 pandemic; this would have been the club's highest finish since reforming in 1971. At the end of the 2020/21 season they were transferred to the Premier Division South of the Combined Counties League.

During their first season in the Combined Counties League. Beckenham were Premier Division South champions, earning promotion to the Isthmian League. In their first season in the Isthmian League the club finished fourth. gualifying for the promotion play-offs. They went on to lose 1-0 to Whitehawk in the semi-finals. This season the Becks find themselves bottom of the table, six points from safety but with two games in hand including against their relegation rivals.





## IF YOU KNOW THEIR HISTORY...

A single goal was all it took to stop Beckenham making the Isthmian South-East play-off final last season and attempting to record back-to-back promotions from the Combined Counties League. Already at their highest level in their history, the Becks just failed to go one higher after a fourth-place finish last season.


