	This Position requires flexibility and a willingness to work non-standard hours in accordance with the needs of the Club. The successful candidate will be required at home fixtures along with travelling to away fixtures with the First Team.

	The role requires a football analysis specialist who is motivated, prepared and willing to provide in depth review and data and able to be self-driven and ambitious to assist the first team manager and club.

	 To create and maintain tactical databases using Hudl Sportscode; and Manage the university or college student placements. Assist with and take ownership of matchday logistics and preparations along with other members of the performance team.
